## **GREEN HEAT PROGRAM**

The Efficiency Nova Scotia's Green Heat Program offers incentives to homeowners who purchase advanced solid-fuel burning appliances to replace an existing electric-heating system. Appliances purchased must meet certain requirements. Those requirements can be summarized as follows:

APPLIANCE TYPE	REQUIREMENT	
Freestanding wood stove	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Wood fireplace insert	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Zero-clearance wood fireplace	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Freestanding pellet stove	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Wood furnace	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or ≤ 0.40 g/MJ as per CSAB415.1-10	
Pellet furnace	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or ≤ 0.40 g/MJ as per CSAB415.1-10	

Rebates offered under the program can be summarized as follows for each appliance type:

APPLIANCE TYPE	REQUIREMENT	
Freestanding wood stove	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Wood fireplace insert	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Zero-clearance wood fireplace	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Freestanding pellet stove	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or CSAB415.1-10	
Wood furnace	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or ≤ 0.40 g/MJ as per CSAB415.1-10	
Pellet furnace	Emissions ≤ 4.5 g/h as per EPA or ≤ 0.40 g/MJ as per CSAB415.1-10

Although the program is intended to be permanent, it is suggested that you register sooner than later in order to start saving money. You need a pre-approval before you buy and install your new appliance. Other conditions apply, such as the need to have the installation performed within two months and inspected by a WETT certified professional.
